The Archdiocesan Summit has been on the drawing Board for several years. When the Plenary Council, which is a gathering of the church in Australia, was planned it was always envisaged that each local Church would need the opportunity to also meet. The Summit from the 18th to the 20th May gives the Church of Brisbane the time to "receive" and discuss the directives and decisions of the Plenary meeting. These decisions first require approval from Rome, which is expected to occur by the end of April.

Archbishop Mark has also prepared some initiatives that he would like discussed and which have been sent to all parishioners who are on the email list. Some hard copies are available at the door of the church.

The Summit is open to representatives from across the Archdiocese. Parishes, Welfare Agencies, Catholic Education, parents, men and women Religious, priests and many others involved in the Mission and Ministry of the local Church will be present.

During the Summit, there will be several keynote speakers, and these include Archbishop Mark, Bishop Tim Norton SVD, an American Catholic author Sherry Weddell and Thelma Parker from Reconciliation Australia.

If you would like to attend one or more sessions of the Summit, which runs from 5:00pm Thursday to 3:00pm Saturday at Riverlife Centre at Seventeen Mile Rocks, then please let me know. Entrance is by ticket only and these are pre-purchased.

Over the weeks from the Second Sunday of Easter until Pentecost, a bulletin insert will introduce each of the seven themes. The second priority is:

Lamps Ablaze: Apostolic Priorities for the Archdiocese of Brisbane

Priority Two: Reshaping Parish Communities

"Our current structures are based upon the facts of an earlier time and our current mode of provision is unsustainable. In the cities at least we have too many parishes and too many churches. Urban parishes were established on the assumption that people had to be able to walk to church and at a time when the numbers attending Mass were much larger. Many of our parishes are pressed financially and cannot provide the range of services which a missionary Church requires. Therefore, we need - sensibly and over time - to move towards larger configurations of a community of communities where the concentration of personnel and the sharing of resources would allow a greater range of services for the sake of the Gospel."
