Fifth Sunday of <mark>Easter</mark>

The topic of synodality is much talked about in Church circles these days. It means 'to walk together' and Pope Francis speaks strongly in terms of walking together being at the heart of the Church. For Francis we walk together with the risen Lord, with fellow members of His Body, the Church, and with the human family and all of creation. Listening to God and one another is vital to being a synodal Church. At this time in our history, we are amid a Church Synod on the topic of synodality itself. The first session was in Rome last year and the second session will be in Rome later this year.

In a very similar vein, the Australian Church held a Plenary Council, once again over two sessions, and the recommendations coming from those gatherings are still being received by the dioceses of Australia. In Brisbane we are having a meeting of the whole Archdiocese on 6th and 7th September with a second session on 11th and 12th October to discuss those same recommendations and enact them in practical ways. This is hopefully all part of the process of discerning the voice of the Holy Spirit as we walk together in the Australian Church.

Two representatives are invited from the Deanery to attend the two sessions of the Brisbane Synod. If you feel called to participate in this process, I strongly encourage you to contact me so that we can discuss it further. There will be ample information to assist in preparing for the gathering. The agenda is based on the recommendations of the earlier Plenary Council and how these can be applied to the local Church of Brisbane. Please prayerfully consider this invitation and keep the Synod in your prayers.
