Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time



FATHER JOSEPH CANALI

This coming Thursday (August 15), amidst the hype and excitement of the EKKA week, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Assumption. Coincidentally for our parish, the day is also the anniversary of the death in 1915 of Fr Joseph Canali, described in a book by Archbishop James Duhig (*The Crowded Years*) as "the Apostle of Brisbane".

Renowned for his prayerfulness, humility and selflessness in charitable works, Fr Canali would travel each week over a period of some 11 years across the river from St Patrick's in the Valley where he lived, to Bulimba to celebrate Mass and hear confessions.

Joseph Augustin Canali was an architect and engineer living in Rome when he was approached by James Quinn, first Catholic bishop of Brisbane, to come to Australia to assist in the completion of the new St Stephen's Cathedral in 1872. He went on to design and build projects around Brisbane,

the most notable being the stone gateway to All Hallows School on Ann St.

Although his grasp of English was limited, his knowledge of Science and Mathematics earned him a job for several years at St James School in Spring Hill and St Kilians (near the site of what is now St Laurence's College). It was while at this latter school that Canali began his studies for the priesthood and was later ordained in 1879.

In December, 1915, Archbishop Duhig wrote after a visit to Bulimba parish: "We did not know the extent of the silent work he (Fr Canali) was doing in the great cause here, nor did we recognise what a wonderful spiritual force he was among the people."

It is certainly not difficult to see the legacy of Fr Canali's presence here in our community today in the many facets of parish life particularly the extraordinary numbers of volunteers who contribute selflessly to the ministries of our parish!
