# Feast of Sts Peter and Paul

An important aspect of our Christian faith and particularly our Catholic belief is the Communion of Saints. Not only their communion with each other in Club Heaven but our communion with them here and now. A prayer to the saints is an act of faith in the resurrection of Christ. Their mission is our mission and the Eucharist which strengthened them is the same Eucharist that strengthens and nourishes us. So, when we celebrate our Patrons Peter and Paul, as we do this weekend, we remember and honour two characters who told the story of Jesus to a hostile and unfriendly society. Their faith in Jesus and their conviction overcame their personal failings and sins. We carry their name; we share their same mission and one day we will be with them.

Part of the simple and ongoing work to enhance the entrance to the Church and Parish Office is the placing of two granite rocks in a new garden. On these rocks will be placed two plaques. One reads:






