Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary

If someone offered you whatever you wished for, what would you ask? What do you truly want? The Word of God poses that question today. At the beginning of his reign and while still a young man Solomon was asked this by God. The young King asked for an understanding heart. In the ancient world the heart was where one's mental capacities resided. He wanted to be a good and worthwhile leader and Solomon measured that not in material success but in his own integrity.


The parables in today's Gospel are unique to Matthew. Regarding the treasure and the pearl, it takes some time to ponder if Jesus is talking about the thing being sought or the person doing the seeking. Reading them together suggests the Jesus is describing how we are to enter the Kingdom of God. The disciple who seeks the hidden treasure and the pearl is the one who is always ready and willing to give up everything to obtain this most precious gift. Jesus is referring to the quality and ongoing readiness for us to be more faithful followers of God's ways. It is not so much giving up of what we have for something better but examining our own lives, priorities and goals. Are we seeking a more authentic expression of who we are called to be and claim to be- children of God and disciples of Jesus. The true and authentic life is the treasure, it is being a faithful participant, rather than winning the World Cup!
