# Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's second reading has St Paul once again teaching about the importance and dignity of baptism. To understand him better some background information about the reading may help. Other preachers had arrived in Colossae teaching a message different from the apostolic Gospel. Nothing new in that. However, their combination of some Christianity with astrology, Greco-Roman mythology and Jewish dietary customs meant that Christ was just one of many heavenly entities amidst a whole mish mash of powers and beliefs. This brought Paul to the defence of true teaching and belief. One can feel the fire in Paul's ink as he reminds the Colossians that Christ is essential to their life in God.

When he says they are to seek what is above, Paul is reminding them that Christ is now raised from the dead and is seated with God and reigns over all of creation. Christ is the first born of creation and through Him all things came into being. His place is unique and those who are baptised belong to Christ. Only in Him can we find unity and be at peace with one another.

This teaching can perhaps make us alert to a number of contemporary "spiritualties" which are little more than superstitions and beliefs around earthly objects and natural coincidences. In faith and through prayer may we continue our life in Christ who unites us and leads us closer to God and one another.
