Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

This year the National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Catholic Council has adopted the NAIDOC theme for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Island Sunday - **Heal Country**. In *Laudato Si'*, Pope Francis has called us to continue to seek greater protections for our lands, our waters, our sacred sites and our cultural heritage from exploitation, desecration, and destruction.

Today's Gospel is very fitting because Mark tells us of Jesus returning to his 'native place' - Nazareth - to a non-accepting, hostile reaction. Jesus had been welcomed and revered in other places, why is it that he is mocked and disregarded in his own home? "Is he not the carpenter?" the crowd called because they saw him as 'without honour' and were unable to believe in him. He did not fit into their ideological view and thus did not deserve respect in their eyes.

In Australia, our own First Nations people have suffered a similar reception to Jesus in Nazareth. Their knowledge and complex cultural systems, created and honed over millennia, are often dismissed as primitive and irrelevant to our fast-paced world of today. This could not be further from the truth, particularly as we become more aware of their continued care, love, and respect for 'country', grounded in a relationship with the Creator that formed independently of Western influence.

2021 marks the 250th Anniversary of the arrival of Christianity in Australia. Yet the Spirit of God was poured out onto the original inhabitants of this great Southern land many, many thousands of years prior. God's Spirit could be heard through the singing of the birds, the cascade of the waterfall, the rustle of the wind and, more importantly, in silence.

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD – please note there is no gathering for children during the school holidays. Children's Liturgy will resume Sunday 18 July at the 8am Mass.

HEAL COUNTRY - Every year, Catholics come together across Australia to acknowledge and celebrate the gifts of Australia's First Peoples. This year is particularly important in the wake of the pandemic and its impact on the ways in which we interacted and made contact with one another. The theme for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Sunday today is 'HEAL COUNTRY'. Today our world is in need of healing – environmentally, spiritually and socially. We must all come together as a global community to fight the injustices of inequality, discrimination of all kinds and environmental damage. Did you know: First Nations Catholics are the youngest and fastest growing demographic in the Australian Catholic Church; there are 133,528 Catholics in Australia who identify as Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander; 16 dioceses across the country have over one-fifth of their Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander population who identify as Catholic; Brisbane has the highest number of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Catholics of all dioceses in Australia.

GREAT NEWS FROM KIRIBATI - Parishioners will be excited to learn that the new buildings at Abaokoro village on Kiribati – the Good Samaritan Early Childhood Centre – for which the parish raised considerable funds several years ago have now been completed. The buildings – a pre-school centre and ablution block – have passed inspection by the Education Department and the final certificate for occupation is pending. The Sisters are naming the new classroom the 'Sts Peter and Paul Building' as a tribute to the generosity of the community here at Sts Peter and Paul's Parish. Thank you, on behalf of the Sisters, to all the parishioners of our parish for yet another example of how our parish reaches out to others. The Sisters have also asked for our on-going prayers for the Catholic community of Kiribati as they deal with the recent passing away of their much-loved Bishop of 40 years, Bishop Paul Mea Kaiuea MSC.
