Peoples. This year's theme, "A New Life in Christ" reflects the hope and promise of a brighter future, rooted in unity and shared commitment to positive change.


There are 135,681 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Catholics and they are the youngest and fastest-growing demographic in the Australian Catholic Church.
