The Most Body and Blood of Christ

Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Corpus Christi.

The feast we celebrate today acknowledges the awesome gift we have received from God which is the Body and Blood of Christ, the Son of God. This gift calls us to acknowledge our identity and to grow in awareness of our life as Christians. St Augustine boldly claimed that in the Eucharist we receive who we are, the Body of Christ. The instruction from Jesus to "Do this in memory of me" reminds us that in receiving His Body and Blood we share in Christ's life and sacrifice which is to be our life of sacrifice and service. Today we delve into Christ's willingness to sacrifice himself for others. When we remember the Last Supper, Jesus' selfless act of love in his suffering and death becomes present to us once again so that we can be transformed.

This weekend we once again joyfully welcome those young people who share the Sacrament of Holy Communion for the first time. They now have completed their journey of Sacramental initiation in to Christ's Body, the Church. As full members of the Church they are growing in awareness of how they can use their gifts and talents to serve God and their world. They now fully belong to the Church and they are fully empowered to be living witnesses of Jesus who is alive among us and at work through us. The ongoing challenge for parents is to discern how these young people can indeed be of service to the community and wider society. Congratulations to them and to their families who have prepared them.


