The Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ

We welcome and congratulate more than eighty children who receive Holy Communion for the first time and their families to Sts Peter and Paul's this weekend. It is a significant time for them and this faith community. Notwithstanding the obvious it is still left to the Parish to hand on the Sacraments as best we can and with the "resources" we have. We are all relying on the Holy Spirit to guide us in another way perhaps but until that becomes clearer, we do what we can.
