Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

This weekend at the 8.00am Mass we welcome a number of families from Sts Peter and Paul's Primary School. The children will participate in some of the ministries during Mass and everyone is welcome to morning tea following Mass. All COVID requirements have been addressed and we thank you in advance for your cooperation.

The children's participation at Mass is a wonderful example of what Jesus was talking about in the Gospel today. Faith in God's love for us grows as we share in the ways of God and join the community in prayer and worship. This is particularly the case with those children who have completed their initiation into the Church through their first Holy Communion. What are they going to do to put into action their belonging to the Church? Most of us learn and develop by doing and it is no different with faith and developing a relationship with God and the Church which is the Body of Christ in the world.

I have a request to parents which I make sincerely and quite seriously. Could you ask your child if they would like to be a server at Mass? This is sometimes called being a junior minister. Training would be provided at school, supervised by Mrs Esbensen and supported by the parish. The children would minister in groups of two or three and your commitment would be every month or even six weeks. In the next week or so I will provide a more formal invitation.

On the same topic you would be aware and may have participated in a 45-minute Baptismal Preparation Session on a Sunday morning. I invite you to consider being involved in that ministry. Parents speaking and sharing their experiences is, once again, a powerful means of sharing faith. All of the content for the session is provided and shared in new and very user friendly equipment. Any questions the parents may ask relate to practical aspects of the ceremony. I very much encourage you to consider being involved in this delightful experience and perhaps work with a friend as a team. They are always a joyful time as young parents prepare for this special event. You see these parents at the Welcome Mass and even the children play their part. Can you please consider doing the same in a simple but meaningful way? Please contact me via the Office if you are interested or have any questions.

PENARY COUNCIL - The Australian Catholic Bishops Conference has formally convoked the Fifth Plenary Council of Australia, with its president Archbishop Mark Coleridge signing the required decree on Pentecost Sunday. The decree of convocation is the final necessary step while preparing for the celebration of a plenary council. It has been 80 years since the last plenary council in Australia. "The journey of the Council began long ago and this is just another step on the way towards the first assembly in the first week in October," Archbishop Coleridge said after signing the decree. "And on Pentecost Sunday we have invoked the Holy Spirit upon the entire journey of the Plenary Council, but in particular upon the first assembly - to which we now move." (*With thanks to ACBC*)
