FEAST OF ST PETER AND ST PAUL – this week we celebrate the solemnity of our parish's patron saints.

St. Peter was one of the original Apostles. He was a fisherman before he was called to follow Jesus. Originally, Peter's name was Simon. Jesus asked the apostles, "Who do you say that I am?" Simon said, "You are the Messiah, the son of the living God." Jesus then said: "Blessed are you Simon, Son of Jonah, for flesh and blood have not revealed this to you but my heavenly Father. And so I say to you, you are Peter and upon this rock I will build my church and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it. I will give you the keys to the kingdom of heaven. Whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven." St. Peter is the patron saint of fishermen. He is considered the first Pope of the Catholic Church.

St. Paul was not one of the original apostles. While persecuting Christians after the death of Jesus, he was thrown to the ground by a bright light. He heard a voice asking him, "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?" He responded with "Who are you, Lord?" Jesus answered him: "I am Jesus whom you are persecuting. But get up and enter the city and you will be told what you are to do." Paul was blinded by the light for three days after which scales fell from his eyes. He then joined the apostles, becoming known as "The Apostle of the Gentiles". He wrote many of the letters in the New Testament.

St. Paul is the patron saint of writers, the press, and missionaries.
