Second Sunday

In the Scriptures, the desert is the place to discover the limits of the human spirit, and the mountain is the place to encounter the spirit of God. During Lent, we visit both: last week the desert, today the mountain.

In Genesis God directs Abram to leave his home for a new land. An encounter with God often leads to a journey and we can observe the life of our catechumens to see this truth lived in our time. This journey represents a new spiritual discovery in the relationship with God. Referring to our Lenten journey, we embark on a spiritual journey of self-examination. Abram is called to take up a physical journey, which is an enormous undertaking since it involves his entire household of extended family, slaves and workers. Added to this is the fact that Abram is given no definite destination nor map to get there. This journey requires faith and it will be a wonderful display of God's providence at every step. Whenever God asks us to move into the future and deepen our relationship with him, we are accompanied by blessings only God can provide.

The transfiguration of the Lord is an example of a biblical theophany, a manifestation in a physical way of the divine among us. Jesus goes up a high mountain where there will be echoes of earlier theophanies such as Moses at Sinai when he received the Law and his face shone brightly reflecting the light of God. God spoke to Moses from a cloud, as was the case for Jesus at his baptism. These details strongly remind us that the mission of Jesus is deeply rooted in God's loving plan of our salvation. As Jesus and the Apostles come down from the mountain, it is clear this work of God will continue as will God's call to us to journey with Jesus.

CHORUS


I will walk in your presence my Lord, In the land of your loved creation. I will live in the radiance of your gaze, From the warmth of your heart, my God.
