Palm Sunday of the Passio<mark>n of the Lord</mark>

With the celebration this Sunday of Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion we commence Holy Week. The only week of the year which we dare to name as such. It is good to remember why. Sadly, it is not because we spend more time in church than any other week and so we must just be more holy. No, we remember in sign, symbol and sacrament the love of God for us. The only truly holy one, Jesus, with a love that perseveres through betrayal, suffering and death is prepared to sacrifice everything for us. Divine life fills humanity at its worst and at its best now making life for us, not a path of despair but a path to holiness. I encourage all of you to participate as much as you can in the liturgies of the sacred Triduum and to rejoice as a people of faith the joy and hope of Easter day. Thanks to the Holy Spirit and those willing to listen to her, several churches in the Bulimba area gather regularly to celebrate our shared Christian faith. The local ministers often meet to share and support one another. The Easter events, so important to us all, are an obvious invitation to meet. Today, Palm Sunday, there will be the annual local Palm Sunday Peace walk down Oxford Street. This will commence at 2.00pm at New Heart Church on Lytton Rd opposite Bulimba Uniting Church. There will be a few stops along the way to Memorial Park for us to hear scripture, pray together and offer intercessions for the city and the world.

On Sunday morning we share the joy of this feast with a 6.00am Easter Resurrection Service at Riverside Park in Addison St Bulimba. Everyone is very welcome to these events as we rejoice in Christ who holds all his disciples in his life giving embrace.


