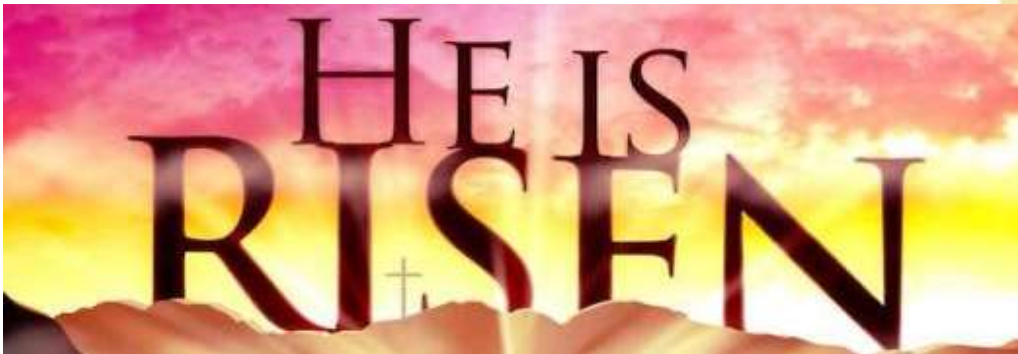


NEWSLETTER

THANK YOU to the parishioners who very generously donated towards the Easter flowers displayed in the church this year.

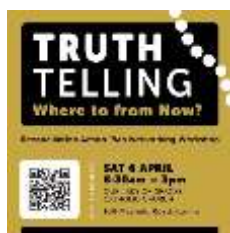
