Fifth Sunday of Easter

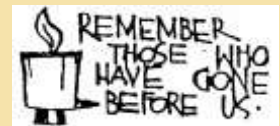

LAUDATO SI' – The Challenge

Seven years ago this week, Pope Francis released his landmark encyclical *Laudato Si': On Care for Our Common Home*. Its contents have challenged world leaders and indeed everyone to focus on the effects of climate change and the care for this earth that God has provided for us. The attached article to this week's emailed Newsletter describes what *Laudato Si'* is all about. Please take a moment to read and consider the quotes, prayers, resources and, yes, even *Laudato Si'* recipes! Pope Francis writes in his encyclical that 'the urgent challenge to protect our common home includes a concern to bring the whole human family together to seek a sustainable and integral development, for we know that things *can* change....I urgently appeal, then, for a new dialogue about how we are shaping the future of our planet....All of us can cooperate as instruments of God for the care of creation each according to his or her own culture, experience, involvements and status.' The chapter headings of the encyclical outline this uncompromising challenge: *What is It is Happening to our Common Home – The Gospel of Creation – The Human Roots of the Ecological Crisis – Integral Ecology – Lines of Approach and Action – Ecological Education and Spirituality*. Our parish's Social Justice Group has accepted the challenge of raising awareness of these issues through participating in the worldwide *Laudato Si'* *Action Platform*, a plan of action and sharing in association with Catholic groups and parishes around the world. Please consider how you yourself can take positive steps to address these challenges as well.
