Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

All Gospel readings for this year's Ordinary Time 2022 use the Gospel of Saint Luke, except for the Second Sunday. The Gospel of Luke shows us the universality of the Christian faith, emphasizing Jesus' love for humanity, especially the sinners, the weak and the poor. This Sunday, the Word of God expresses the need for compassion and empathy in our living relationships with those around us. The parable, which is referred to in the Gospel of Luke, is often called the Story of "Lazarus and Divés".

The name of the poor man Lazarus is clearly mentioned. However, the author may have intentionally not named the rich man in this parable. The word 'Divés' is a Latin word that translates as 'Rich'. Therefore, it is actually not a name, but rather a description because, in the society of that time, the rich were often named to assert their status in society, while the poor were often the ones who were not mentioned. Perhaps, Saint Luke wants to remind us that this rich man could be each of us. The rich man was insensitive to the suffering of the poor man lying in front of his house. The prophet Amos condemned the exploitation and lack of concern for the poor in society and foretold the cruel fate they would suffer from God. The readings this weekend invite us to live in solidarity with others, especially the poor, sick and weak around us. That is the core of the Christian faith and what Jesus always calls us to live: the Word of God and put it into practice.
