

**THE COMMON GOOD IN A COVID WORLD** – the Catholic Bishops of Qld have recently released a statement for the 2020 State Election (31 October) – *The Common Good in a Covid World*. The Statement urges us to remember that our Christian faith is not a private matter: 'It shapes how we live our lives in public, as well as how we relate to God in more personal ways.' Issues at the forefront, for example, include care for the poor and vulnerable, health, Catholic schooling, the dignity of workers and climate change, to name a few. 
